Entry Procedures: to enter your cat(s) in competition, go to the website: oct.evergreencatfanciers.org. Click on the header "Enter the Show" and follow the instructions. Fill out Summary sheet on website. Enter each cat in the show via the TOES online entry system via the link on the website. Pay for your entries and other services.

Added Safety Requirements: At the time of entry, all exhibitors must agree to the safety requirements for this event posted on the show's website. Anyone not complying with these added precautions will be instructed to leave without refund of any monies paid.

Airport Information: The closest airport is Bellingham International Airport (BLI) which is 6 miles from the show hall and hotel. The other option is Sea-Tac International Airport (SEA), which is 85 miles south of Ferndale.

Show Hall: Ferndale Events Center, located at 5715 Barrett Road, Ferndale, WA 98248. Phone: 800-449-4393. Catered lunches are available and must be pre-ordered/purchased by 10:00pm, Monday, October 5, 2020. **Fill out separate Lunch Order Form.** Cat litter provided by club. Sorry, there will not be a hospitality table at this show. **Bring your own drinks, snacks, cat food, food dishes, and litter pans.** Note: The Ferndale Events Center no longer allows overnight RV's or camping in its parking lot!

Health/Safety Precautions: The Club will follow government mandated health and safety guidelines in effect on the show dates. Bring your own face masks and sanitizer/disinfectant for your personal benching space. You may also want to bring your own protective gloves. Additional information will be posted on the show's website.

Show Hours: Sat/Sun: 9am-5pm. Saturday check-in: 7:30am-8:30am. Sunday check-in: 8:00-8:30am.

Directions to Ferndale Events Center: (from the North) Take Interstate 5 South. Take Exit 262 (Axton Road). Turn left on Axton Road. Go one block. Take a left on Barrett (by McDonalds). The Ferndale Events Center is on the left. **(from the South)** Take Interstate 5 North. Take Exit 262 (Axton Road). Turn left on Axton Road. Go one block. Turn left on Barrett. The Ferndale Events Center is on the left.

Show Hotel: Four Points by Sheraton, located at 714 Lakeway Drive, Bellingham, WA 98229, about 7 minutes south of the Ferndale Events; . Hotel amenities include: pillowtop beds, free wi-fi high-speed internet access, free local calls, free parking, waived pet fee, business center, indoor swimming pool, and fitness center. **Note: The Hotel also has a 24 hour free shuttle to/from the Bellingham International Airport.** Call them direct for airport pick up. Take extra care to clean up litter, food and other spills. Protect the rooms from spraying cats by confining them in cages or keeping them in the bathroom. Exhibitors staying at the **Four Points by Sheraton** agree to abide by TICA's Hotel Room Inspection Policy. The club will provide free shuttle to/from the hotel & show hall, if prearranged via email to: showmanager@evergreencatfanciers.org .

Room rates: \$109.00 for single or double occupancy. For reservations: Cal the hotel at 360-671-1011 or book online at <https://www.marriott.com/event-reservations/reservation-link.mi?id=1598469510311&key=GRP&app=resvlink>. To get the group rate and special concessions, **book no later than September 24, 2021** under the block name of The Evergreen Cat Fanciers, Reference # M-L7FBXIT. After that, the hotel's prevailing rates will be in force and will be based on availability.

Directions to Hotel: From the South: From I-5 heading northbound take Exit 256A-B, take ramp right for WA-539 toward Lynden, turn right onto WA-539 / Guide Meridian Rd / Meridian St, turn right onto Telegraph Rd (at Shari's), turn right onto E McLeod Rd.

From the North: From I-5 heading southbound take Exit 256, take ramp right towards Bellis Fair Mall Pkwy / Meridian St, Bear left onto McLeod Rd, Turn left onto WA-539 / Meridian Guide Meridian Rd, turn right onto Telegraph Rd, Turn right onto E McLeod Rd.

Special Events (more info on summary sheet and website)

Cat Costume & Cage Decorating Contest(s) — We will be having the traditional Halloween cat costume and cage decorating contests. Trophies going to the top 3 in each.

JE Judging — The Junior Exhibitor judging will take place on Saturday during the lunch break (just before afternoon judging). Judge: TBA

Saturday Evening Regional Banquet and Awards — Following a catered dinner, regional awards will be presented for the 2020-2021 show season that ended April 30, 2021.

Junior Exhibitors: Any questions about the Junior Exhibitor program should be directed to Sauncha Romey, the Junior Exhibitor Coordinator at Sauncha.Romey@yahoo.com. JE's who are currently in TICA's JE program are eligible to receive the special JE entry rate. Each JE entry includes a regular show entry and double cage. For more information go to the club's website.

Show Photographer: there will NOT be a show photographer at this show.

Benching: Only one benching request will be allowed. **If you list more than one, only the first request will be considered. Due to safety precautions, we will have 6' between exhibitors in the benching area. Exhibitors can opt to be directly benched with another exhibitor but must note that on the Summary Sheet.** Handicapped exhibitors will receive preferential and "free" end-of-row benching, if requested. All other end-of-row request will be benched on a first-come, first-served, space available basis at a cost of \$15.00. Entry clerk will make every attempt to bench your cats per your request, however, the club does not guarantee that all benching requests can be honored due to space limitations and show hall configuration.

Cage size: The club's cages are 21" tall, 21" deep, and 45" wide and has a 3" divider in the middle which can be easily be used as one large cage or it can be split into 2 cages if you need to separate multiple cats. Every 'odd numbered' entry includes a double cage space. Benching is sold in increments of double cage space only!

Personal cages: If your personal cage is wider than 45", you must also purchase a groom space to accommodate the extra width. The maximum depth for a personal cage is 24" deep. If your cage is deeper than 24", it will not fit on our 24" deep tables. If you plan to use your personal cage, please note this on the summary sheet.

Other Cage Requirements: The top, floor, sides, and back of the cage must be covered. Per TICA rules, only one cat or two kittens per 1/2 double cage, and two cats or four kittens per double cage.

Exhibition/For Sale Cages: Due to benching restrictions, **Limit: 1 Exhibition cage with maximum of 2 Exhibition Cats per Exhibitor. Exhibition cages are standard cage size (see above).** You must complete an entry form for each kitten/cat on exhibition; All cats/kittens in the show hall must be listed in the exhibitor catalog. No exceptions! No cat or kitten will be allowed in the show hall if it is not listed in the catalog.

Ring Clerks/Stewards: Clerks will receive lunch plus \$40 for each full day of clerking. Clerks will be paid after clerking, please do not deduct clerking fees from your entry form. Preference will be given to those in the TICA clerking program. The Club is also in need of good stewards for the show. Stewards will receive lunch plus \$20/ring for each full day of stewarding.

Show Catalogs: One show catalog is included free with your first entry. Additional show catalogs are \$5 each and must be pre-ordered on the Summary Sheet. No catalogs will be available for sale in the show hall. The show committee accepts no responsibility for catalog errors due to illegibility or mistakes on the entry form.

Kitten Age Requirements: to compete, kittens must be **4 calendar months old (born on or before June 9, 2021)**. To be allowed in the show hall, kittens must be **3 calendar months old (born on or before July 9, 2021)**. **Note:** If the Entry Clerk requests it, a TICA litter registration must be provided at the time of entry. Any kitten without proof of age will not be entered in the show, nor will it be allowed in the show hall.

Household Pets (HHP's): HHP Kittens (4 to 8 months old) do NOT need to be altered. HHPs over 8 months of age must be altered (neutered or spayed). Please phone the entry clerk if you are not sure how to describe your cat's color, or if you have any questions about how to fill out the entry form.

Registration: All cats, kittens, and alters shown with a "pending" registration number must provide proof that the cat can be TICA registered to be entered in a show. Our entry clerking program is TOES which will require the submission of the appropriate "proof" when the exhibitor puts their entry information in the system. The following can be submitted to prove registration eligibility:

1. A copy of your TICA registration application. This can be a screenshot of the tica.org ticket for the registration or a copy of the individual registration application.
2. A copy of the TICA Breeder Slip for the cat.
3. A copy of the TICA litter registration for your cat's litter.
4. A copy of the pedigree for your cat issued by a (recognized association).
5. A copy of the pedigree or registration papers for both the sire and dam of your cat issued by a (recognized association).
6. A copy of other registration documents for your cat issued by a (recognized organization) indicating the cat's breed. Contact the TICA Executive Office for specific registration procedures.

Liability: The Evergreen Cat Fanciers, TICA, Ferndale Events Center, and the contracted show hotel, will not be held liable for **illness**, injury, loss or damage to cats, exhibitors, property of exhibitors, vendors or other such persons or property in attendance.

Health: This is a non-vetted show. Every cat that enters the show hall must conform to normally accepted health requirements and be up-to-date on its vaccinations. Front and back claws must be clipped. Cats from households with contagious or infectious illnesses within the last 21 days are ineligible for entry. *Cats with suspected contagious or infectious illness or with parasites will be removed from the show hall.* **Special Health/Safety Policies and Procedures will be in force at this show should the state revert back to controlled attendance requirements (see attached). Decision about masks will be announced 10/1/21.**

Show Rules: All exhibitors agree to abide by and uphold the show rules of TICA. Show rules and registration information are available from TICA, PO Box 2684, Harlingen, TX 78551, (956) 428-8046 or from the TICA website: www.tica.org

Other Important Club Rules: With the exception of cats available for adoption by rescue organizations, no other cats or kittens are allowed in the show hall unless they are listed in the official show catalog. No cat or kitten sales are allowed from carriers.

Closing Dates, Payment and Fees:

- **Closing Date/Time: for all entries and all services ordered must be received & paid by 10:00pm, Sunday, October 3, 2021.**
- Submitting entry information (summary sheet or a cat entry form) via the club's website, phone, email or snail-mail constitutes an agreement to pay for all services ordered, even if you withdraw from the show, fail to attend the show, or fail to complete the entry process. The only way you would not owe entry fees is if the show is cancelled. Substitutions may be made up to 10pm, Sunday, October 3, 2021.
- Pay all fees in U.S. funds by money order, bank check, or PayPal to treasurer@evergreencatfanciers.org. Make check or cashier checks payable to "The Evergreen Cat Fanciers" c/o Tracy Hisel, Entry Clerk. See upper right hand corner of page 1 for mailing address. Only checks from a United States bank can be accepted. No post-dated checks. Any excess payment will be considered a donation to the show.
- Cats co-owned by members of two different households are eligible for multiple entry discounts ONLY if a photocopy of the cat's TICA owners

registration accompanies the cat's entry showing the names of both co-owners.

- Extra fees:
 - End-of-row benching (not handicapped) - \$15.00.
 - Phone entry fee — \$5.00/entry.
 - Substitution fee — \$10.00/entry.
 - Extra catalog — \$10.00/each.
 - Returned check fee—\$30.00 plus any bank fees charged to the Club.
 - Late fee — Any exhibitor Sunday, October 3, 2021, will be assessed a \$25.00 late fee. Payment at the door will be at the sole discretion of the Entry Clerk, and will be subject to the \$25.00 late fee, and MUST be paid in cash or cashier's check. No exceptions!

- * **I will abide by and uphold the health safety requirements in force at this show.**

The Evergreen Cat Fanciers Summary Sheet—Continued

TICA Rules (partial list):

Show Rule 29.2.3 -- Under no circumstances may the show management accept entries not printed in the catalog. This does not apply to entries accepted prior to the printing of the catalog which have been inadvertently omitted by the show management (sometimes referred to as a "Late Page"). Therefore, the exhibitor will not bring any cats/kittens in the Show Hall that are NOT listed in the official show catalog (Show Rules, Article 10 – Responsibilities of Exhibitors).

Show Rule 29.2.3.1 -- No substitute cats or kittens can be accepted in place of the original entry printed in the catalog.

Show Rule 23.4 – cats or kittens obviously pregnant are ineligible for competition.

Show Rule 23.8.1 – No kitten under the age of three (3) calendar months is permitted in the show hall under any circumstance.

Show Rule 26.1.2 – No more than two (2) kittens or one (1) cat may be benched in a single cage, whether entered for competition, exhibition or for sale.

Show Rule 24.3 – Each entry shall be accompanied by the published fee. No entry fee or related charges will be returned except for failure on the part of the sponsoring club to hold a "Vetted" show as advertised, or if there is change in the advertised judges, date, location and/or format of the show as set forth in Show Rule 24.3.1. In such cases, the club shall refund the total amount if requested by the Exhibitor.

Show Rule 25.3 and 210.6 – No exhibitor shall bring into the show hall any cat, whether for show, exhibition, sale, or otherwise, which is infested with any parasite, including but not limited to fleas, ear mites, lice or ticks.

Standing Rule 205.3, -- If a cat is suspect under Show Rules 25.3, it is the duty of the Show Manager to have the cat in question immediately removed from the show hall until a veterinarian confirms and/or diagnoses the suspected illness or certifies that the cat is free from contagious or infectious illness. Further, it is acknowledged that in no event is the Club or show management required to refund entry fees (Per Standing Rule 205.3.5).

Show Rule 26.1.1 – No change in benching arrangements shall be made without the permission of the show management.

Show Rule 29.5.2 – The Show Committee, at its discretion, may refuse to allow the distribution of any printed material that contains a defamatory statement about another exhibitor or TICA member, the Association, or any appointed or elected official of the Association. See Show Rule 29.5.2 for the complete list

Show Rule 29.5.3 – Except as provided in 29.5.2.2.1 and 29.5.2.2.2, the Show Committee, at its discretion, may refuse to allow the distribution of printed materials by vendors, spectators, exhibitors, or any other person in attendance at a TICA sanctioned show.

Show Rule 23.6.5 – The show committee, at its discretion, may refuse to accept any entry for the following reason: Prior conduit of the entry and/or exhibitor is detrimental to the best interest of the association or the welfare of cats or the club and/or its show.

Club Rules:

Special Health/Safety Policies and Procedures may be in force at this show (see attached) depending on government mandates for social distancing or the wearing of face masks. Also, all exhibitors may be required to complete the TECF Health Questionnaire and present it at the onsite check-in.

With the exception of cats available for adoption by rescue organizations, no other cats or kittens are allowed in the show hall unless they are listed in the official show catalog.

No cat or kitten sales are allowed from carriers.

No cats/kittens may be kept in carriers underneath the benching area.

Exhibition/For Sale cats. An exhibitor who has at least one cat entered and competing in the cat show, can purchase an Exhibition/For Sale cage, provided space is available. The exhibitor must complete an entry form for each kitten or cat for sale and/or on exhibition and have them listed in the printed catalog. No cat or kitten will be allowed in the show hall if it is not listed in the catalog. The ONLY exception allowed is for rescue groups with cats/kittens for adoption. The exhibitor must comply with all TICA rules regarding maximum numbers allowed per cage (i.e., no more than 2 adults or 4 kittens in a double cage).

Cat/Kitten sales. Any exhibitor/Owner who sells or places a cat or kitten with another person, where transfer of ownership occurs in the show hall, shall comply with the following:

A sales agreement will be used for the transaction specifically showing contract terms. Both parties will execute the agreement in the show hall and each shall retain one copy for their records.

The Exhibitor/Owner shall notify the Show Manager of the sale/placement prior to the cat/kitten leaving the show hall. The Show Manager will provide a signed authorization form to the Exhibitor/Owner so the cat/kitten can leave the show hall.

The Exhibitor/Owner shall escort the new Owner out of the show hall with the cat/kitten in a secure, enclosed carrier.

The Exhibitor/Owner shall stop at the front gate to provide the staff with a signed authorization by the Show Manager that it is okay to let the New Owner to leave with the cat/kitten.

The Club is not liable for any contractual agreements of any kind (verbal or written) between the seller or buyer of any cat(s).

If the Exhibitor/Owner fails to comply with any of these procedures and rules described in this show flyer and/or Club website, the Exhibitor/Owner may be required by the Show Manager to pay the Club a fine up to \$100.00 US for each infraction for non-compliance.

If the Exhibitor/Owner refuses to pay the assessed fine for any rule infraction, the Club has the right to turn the exhibitor in to the TICA Executive Office as a bad debt and therefore, the Exhibitor/Owner acknowledges they will not be able to conduct any business with the TICA organization until said payment has been received by the Club.

The Exhibitor/Owner also understands that non-compliance with these procedures and rules may ban them from visiting or entering any cats at future Club shows.

The Club is not liable for any action of any exhibitor or spectator/visitor at a sponsored show.

Health/Safety Policies and Procedures for Participants
for the October 9-10, 2021 Show**

I agree to abide by the following Health/Safety Policies and Procedures:

1) General Policies

- A) This show will be Open to the Public for health and safety reasons.
- B) Everyone must sign this document indicating they have read, understood, and agree to these Health and Safety Policies and Procedure in force at this agricultural event.
- E) All persons entering the show hall agrees to the following general health policies at all times:
 - a. Comply with social distancing; remain six feet away from others.
 - b. Wear face mask at all times while in the show hall.
 - c. Use sanitizer on your hands several times throughout the day.
- F) Hand sanitizing stations will be placed at the entrance and throughout all common areas. Participants are to bring their own personal hand sanitizers for the benching area.
- G) Dedicated staff will frequently clean all touch points throughout the show hours. The show hall will be thoroughly cleaned, sanitized and disinfected Friday and Saturday evenings for the next day's events.
- H) Participants will bath all cats prior to arriving at the event.
- I) We encourage participants to clean and disinfect all equipment being brought from home before entering the show hall and again before they take them back home.
- J) We discourage the sharing of items/equipment that are difficult to disinfect between participants.

2) Check-in Procedures

- A) Participants will maintain social distancing while proceeding through the check-in procedures.
- B) All people will complete and provide a short health questionnaire at check-in (copy attached).
- C) All people entering the show hall must have their temperature taken with a non-contact thermometer.
- D) If a person has multiple symptoms and a temperature is present (+100.4 Fahrenheit), the person (and their party) will not be admitted to the facility.
- D) All people entering the show hall must provide and use the following safety gear:
 - a. Face mask
 - b. Protective gloves
 - c. Sanitizer/disinfectant for personal benching space
- E) If people do not have the items in 2D above, safety kits, including 2 face masks, 2 pair protective gloves, and personal sized sanitizer, will be available for \$5.00/person.

3) Benching Areas

- A) Participants will be benched with 6 feet between themselves and other Participants.
- B) A participant may opt out of this requirement should they wish to waive that right (See Summary Sheet). As an example, participants who travel and/or typically bench together can opt for no separation of cages and/or groom spaces. To be benched closer than 6' to each other, all parties in the group must agree to be benched together.

4) Ring Protocol

- A) Ring staff will clean/disinfect the ring equipment (cat cages and judging table) after the space has been occupied by a cat and/or their handler.
- B) There will be no chairs in the rings for viewing judging or finals.
- C) Participants are to put their cats in the ring cages. After judging, remove cats as quickly and quietly as possible.
- D) Participants are to follow signage instructions regarding the entry and exit points in the judging rings, so people do not pass close together while coming/going out of the rings.
- E) Do not deliver or pick up cats directly behind a judge when they have a cat on the judging table.
- E) Maintain social distancing.
- F) Finals will be presented in two phases -- bottom 5 presented and excused, then top 5 presented and excused so there are limited people observing the finals.

5) People Food & Drinks

- A) There will be a hospitality table (coffee, tea, hot chocolate, snacks) at this show. Participants are to bring their own drinks, snacks, and meals. Participants can pre-purchase contactless Saturday/Sunday lunches and Saturday banquet dinner (see Summary Sheet). The Club will still provide drinks to the judging rings (judges, ring clerks, and stewards).
- B) Meals (Lunches and Dinner)
 - a. All meals (lunches and dinner) will be pre-packaged in individual containers and delivered contactless. Each meal will have the appropriate condiments including plastic utensils, paper napkin, and individual serving salad dressings (if applicable).
 - b. Ring staff (Judge, clerk, and steward) lunches will be delivered to the judging rings.
 - c. Participant and club staff lunches will be in alphabetical order in the kitchen. To maintain social distancing, the number of people in the kitchen will be limited and monitored by Club staff. All lunches are to be eaten at individual benching areas (and not in the dining rooms).
 - d. For all those attending the Saturday evening banquet, meals will be set up in alphabetical order in the kitchen. To maintain social distancing, the number of people in the kitchen will be limited and monitored by Club staff. Dining tables will be set up 6 feet apart with only 3 to 4 people per table.
